CLUBHOUSE RULES FOR NON-RENTED COMMUNITY EVENTS FOREST HILLS OF LONDONDERRY CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION

- 1. The community will have access to all of the products that are provided in the clubhouse storage and cabinets by the association.
- All small community groups reserving and using the clubhouse on an ongoing basis must be responsible for cleaning up after themselves. This could include removing trash; cleaning floors, tabletops, countertops, and appliances; and returning items (glasses etc.) to the proper cabinets at the end of their usage.
- 3. After a community wide function, the cleanup of the clubhouse, as defined in #2 above, is, as much as possible, the responsibility of all of the attendees.
- 4. Extra items like old coffee pots, toasters, and other electronics, etc. that are not designated clubhouse items should not be left in the clubhouse. The clubhouse inventory is reviewed twice a year, and any needed additional items will be purchased new.
- 5. Anything left over from what is brought in such as food and utensils should be brought out.
- 6. Use of the recycling bin and waste barrels in the rear of the building is reserved for these special authorized Association functions.
- 7. No pets are allowed. (Except for service dogs)
- 8. No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds.
- 9. Nothing is to be hung on the clubhouse walls. Notices, however, may be put on the bulletin board by the doorway.
- The clubhouse should be returned to its original state after community events.

Upon closing, please take the following actions:

- a. All lights, television and fireplace are to be turned off.
- b. In winter, heat setting must be turned down to 55 degrees.
- c. In summer, air conditioner is to be turned off.
- d. All doors and windows must be locked and alarm system activated.
